However, ebooks downloaded on the app will not appear on your Mac/PC, and vice versa	Ebooks downloaded to your Mac/PC may be transferred to the ebrary app. Transfer these PDFs to your device through iTunes. Adobe Digital Editions saves PDF copies of downloaded ebooks to your Mac or PC. Default locations for these PDFs are:  OSX: your-home-directory/Documents/Digital Editions  Windows: your-home-directory/Documents/My Digital Editions	Ebooks downloaded to your PC may be transferred to your Android. The easiest method is to drag your downloads into the free <a href="#">Blue Reader</a> app. Adobe Digital Editions saves PDF copies of downloaded ebooks to your PC. The default location for these PDFs is: your-home-directory/Documents/My Digital Editions.
